In October 2021, the pilot phase will launch, with support from local pharmacy committees and community pharmacy Scotland, in the following areas:

How can I PenCycle?

We will provide all the materials you need to get involved, including a blue **PenCycle Recycling Bin**, **PenCycle Return Boxes** and other support materials, **completely free of charge**.

Provide PenCycle Return Boxes to pen users, and collect and store them when pen users return them to you
