Getting drastic with plastic



- We will reduce our use of single-use plastic secondary packaging within the UK business by 60% by September 2022.
- We use 65,000 less invoice bags and we are moving from plastic bubble wrap to a paper alternative.
- We invest in reusable totes** which continue to reduce single-use plastic and cardboard by 2 million units each year.

** H&B totes forecast to replace 2m units of plastic bags and cardboard boxes per year

Reducing waste



- We will responsibly source materials, water and energy that we use.
- We will minimise impacts from emissions or wastes that cannot be avoided.

Recycling



- We've increased recycling by 6%, 170 tonnes more than 2019.
- We promote and encourage re-use and recycling wherever we can.
- 3,000 tonnes of cardboard is recycled annually.

Transport



We're working hard to reduce our collective fuel consumption by:

- Using Microlise telematics and Driving Styles with enhanced driver engagement and training to increase fuel efficiency.
- Continuing to replace our fleet with the latest vans with a euro 6 engine.
- Working with our suppliers to focus on vehicle efficiency.
- Reducing our overall 'miles per tote' through effective route reviews.
- Trialling the latest alternative fuel vehicles in the first half of 2022.

Energy



- We purchase all our electricity from renewable sources.
- We have switched to LED lighting across our main support centre office.
- Natural gas and the use of insulation are options currently being investigated.
