

## Alliance Healthcare UK Environmental Social Governance (ESG) highlights FY21:

- **Alloga UK achieved Gold accreditation from Investors in People (IIP)**
- **Alliance Healthcare UK announced its promise to reduce single-use secondary plastic within the business by 60 percent by the close of FY22** as part of its “Getting Drastic with Plastic” campaign. Amongst other initiatives, the business invests in reusable totes which continue to reduce single-use plastic and cardboard by 2 million units each year.
- To commemorate AmerisourceBergen’s 20th anniversary and to promote healthier futures, **AmerisourceBergen sponsored the planting of 22,000 trees with Trefadder in honor of each Alliance Healthcare UK team member to create a dedicated climate forest in Norway.** The trees will make a positive difference for the planet for generations, guaranteeing a net Carbon Dioxide Removal (CDR) of 3.473 metric tons. This amount is enough to offset an Alliance Healthcare van making 456 trips around the world.
- **Alliance Healthcare UK also continued their 10-year partnership with the European Organisation for Research and Treatment of Cancer (EORTC)** to build and support the first pan-European infrastructure, SPECTA, which allows for the rapid implementation of new clinical trials and robust translational cancer research across tumor types, including rare cancers. It helps guide patients’ treatments based on their own tumor report analysis, diagnosed and confirmed by a group of leading international experts in the field
- **Alloga UK, an Alliance Healthcare business, supports International Health Partners (IHP), a global health NGO** that sources medicine donations from pharmaceutical companies and ships them to help people in disaster-hit and vulnerable communities around the world get access to the treatments they need. In the last year, Alloga UK increased its support to further advance health equity by assuming packing responsibilities as well as storing excess inventory. Without Alloga UK’s expertise and dedication, we would not have been able to send over 14.5 million treatments in 2021, which is an incredible achievement considering the circumstances. Your work packing the Essential Health Packs enables us to get medicines to those who would otherwise go without. Thank you on behalf of the vulnerable people that you are helping.”
