## Alliance Healthcare UK: Our Sustainability At A Glance

Our electricity is currently from a 100% green energy source

Where we have implemented LED lighting in some sites, we have reduced our lighting electricity usage by 40 - 70%

From Jan–June 2022 we recycled 17.54 mt of plastic waste, 50% less than previous years By removing invoice bags in 2020, this has saved 2.4 tonnes a year

Electric van trial arranged with leading vehicle manufacturer to take place on 12th September 2022

We endeavour to send nothing to landfill

Since 2020, we are now using less than half the pallet wrap that we used to

Completion of trial to fit 'Trailar' solar panels to HGVs and LGVs, providing solar power to the vehicle to be used as an alternative to diesel

Purchased more reusable plastic totes to decrease the number of orders that are being bagged




Alliance Healthcare pledge to become Net Carbon Zero\* by 2030.





We purchase our electricity from renewable sources


We have switched to LED lighting across our main support centre office

We are working with suppliers and consultants to constantly look at opportunities to generate our own green electricity via solar panels and/or wind turbines.








## 3. Buildings, Infrastructure and Plastic

Getting drastic with plastic! We're reducing our impact on the environment through our Plastic Strategy.



Our committent: To reduce the use of single-use plastic secondary packaging within the business by 60% (around 16 million plastic bottles) by September 2022



## 3. Buildings, Infrastructure and Plastic (continued)

- We have purchased more reusable plastic totes in the business to decrease the number of orders we are bagging
- Pallet wrap was amongst one of our biggest SUP items in 2019 we used to use ~ 85 tonnes of pallet wrap. We are now using less than half of this on an annual basis
- Invoice bags were removed in 2020 which has bought a 2.4 tonnes saving a year

- We are now working with Carlton packaging and are trialling a paper bubble wrap product called Rapicell at our Leigh SC. This will reduce plastic bubble wrap use at just Leigh by 100% which will be a minimum of 1.26 Tonnes of plastic a year. We are looking to roll this out across the network in 2023
- We currently have LED lighting in our Coatbridge and Leigh sites. This helps reduce our lighting electricity usage by 40 - 70% site dependant therefore reducing the amount of electricity needed and carbon produced

## 4. Transport

To provide the highest standard of service for our customers Alliance Healthcare has built a large, specialised distribution network which utilises a variety of good vehicles.

Using green tariffs and technology\* to increase fuel efficiency by 5%

We have lower emissions on 300 new vans being deployed in FY21 using euro 6 engines technology

We use Microlise Telematics to monitor driver behaviour and help create sustainable driving habits

## 4. Transport (continued)

Due to the limitation of electric vehicles that exist currently, our electrification strategy is broken down into the following areas:



- Identification of LCV journeys which can be electrified based on current electric vehicle ranges and payload availability
- Identification of HGV journeys which can be electrified based on current electric vehicle ranges and payload availability
- Trialling electric vehicles to replace suitable journeys
- Redesign of the Company Car policy to make available and incentivise battery electric vehicles and reduce diesel/petrol business miles

- Entering a long term-partnership with a manufacturer committed to achieving Net Zero targets for future vehicle rollouts
- Working with customers to identify and consolidate suitable journeys
- Trial and rollout of suitable innovations which help to reduce our CO2 emissions
- We are monitoring Drone
   Technology for critical/remote
   destination deliveries

## **Case Study:**

Alliance Healthcare
UK partners with Novo
Nordisk for the launch
of PenCycle; the circular
recycling initiative

Alliance Healthcare UK is delighted to collaborate with Novo Nordisk to help reduce plastic pen devices entering UK landfills by up to 1.1 million in the next year.

Alliance Healthcare / Skills in Healthcare provide support with Pharmacy Recruitment, Pharmacy on Boarding, Distribution of support materials and Collection of the used insulin pens using our full market reach into Pharmacy to enable patients' flexibility and access to this service.

We have developed a customer return and tracking platform which is enabled through our existing AH customer portal so that pharmacy can selfserve on recycling collection bookings and manage the ordering of more patient return packaging and support materials using their standard ordering processes. We can therefore schedule a collection at the same time we make a delivery and provide a net zero carbon collection.

The PenCycle scheme will roll out Nationally with our support in Sep 2022 and we will invite all UK mainland pharmacy to participate.



Thank you for helping us make this recycling initiative a successful one. Together, we can give empty pens a new purpose.
